Sometimes pastors experience trauma themselves either from past experiences of abuse or crisis, from unhealthy congregational relationships or from secondary trauma as they walk with others through their pain.

Central District Conference and Allegheny Mennonite Conference have teamed up to provide a weekend retreat open to all CDC and AMC pastors and either their spouse, a friend, or a support person.
